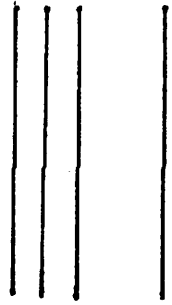

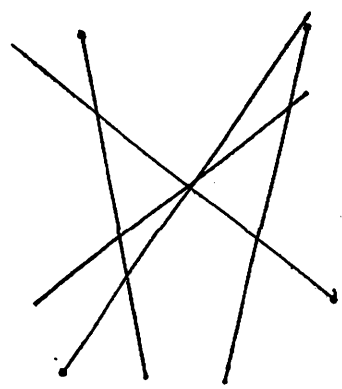

5. Echo Quilting

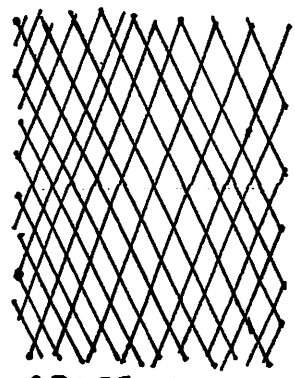

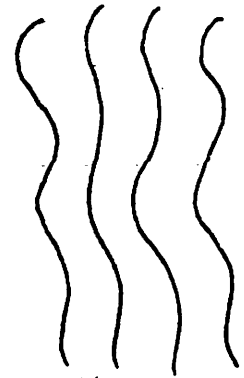

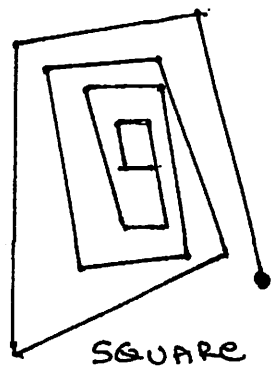


CROSS HATCH

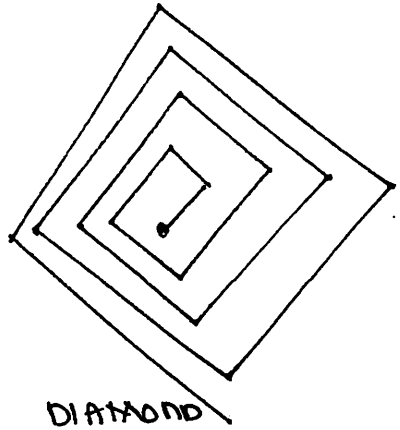

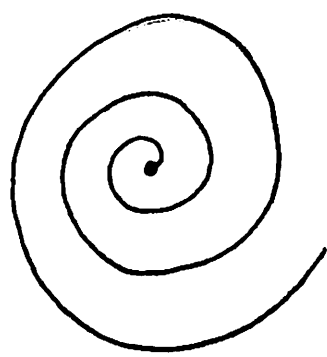

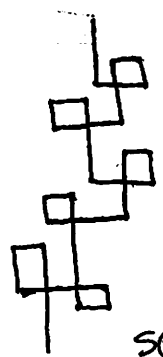

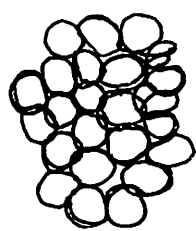
