
FAVORITES SWAP

Triplett fined for misusing campaign cash

Greed, not need, led to clothes and spa spending, she admits.

ST. LOUIS • In 2010, then-city Alderman Kacie Starr Triplett told O, The Oprah Magazine: "As a public official, I don't make a lot of money, but I do believe in buying quality fabrics."

It turns out she had money and did buy fabric, long with clothes and jewelry - all using campare cash.

The Missouri Ethics Commission says that Triplett, the stepped down in 2012, spent thousands of dollars meant for her campaigns while in office to pay studencleans and pamper herself with new clothes, items from a late store, spas, salons

AMAZON SUNDAY DELIVERY IS NEAR

Amazon is working with the local district of the U.S. Postal Service to roll out Sunday delivery in the St. Louis region by mid-March, a move that's expected to put additional pressure on local retailers.

The online retailer, which has been breathing down the necks of brickand-mortar stores for years, made a big splash in November when it first announced that it had partnered with the Postal Service to make Sunday delivery of packages a reality. It launched the service in the New York and Los Ange-

les metro areas.

Amazon said at the time that it would expand Sunday delivery to "a large portion of the U.S. population in 2014" and said some of those new markets would include Dallas, Houston, New Orleans and Phoenix. St. Louis was not specifically mentioned.

But leaders of the local postal unions said they had been told that the target date for Sunday delivery in this region was March 16.

That's the same date provided by David Martin, district manager for the Postal Service's Gateway District, which covers the St. Louis region, in a
